Antiepilettico. Derivato della carbamazepina.

- Vedi Antiepilettici in generale (N03A) e Carbamazepina (N03AF01), di cui è un derivato. Non emerge alcuna differenza sostanziale dagli altri FAE seppure la frequenza d'uso dell'OCBZ, soprattutto in monoterapia sia veramente molto bassa (, Lindhout et al 1992, Friis et al 1993, Lindhout e Omtzigt 1994, Morrell 1996, Sabers et al 1998 , Samren et al 1999, Hvas et al 2000, Kaaja et al 2003, Meischenguiser et al 2003, Isojarvi 2003, Sabers et al 2004, Meischenguiser et al 2004).

Revisioni

- Montouris (2005): ha identificato 248 gravidanze esposte ad oxcarbazina in monoterapia e 61 in politerapia. 6 nati esposti a monoterapia presentavano difetti congeniti (2.4%); 4 esposti a politerapia presentavano difetti congeniti (6.6%).

Conclusioni: vedi la classe generale degli antiepilettici (N03A).
